

Chapter 10 - ठ

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “ठ”

ठिँ - ‘flood’

ठु - ‘six’

ठोप - ‘warm’

ठुप - ‘to sew’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with ठ.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

Chapter 10 Spelling Rule: When writing past tense questions, the question verb uses the -च्यी verb ending, and the answer verb uses the -च्ये verb ending.

आम: “कय ठसिकी चच्यी?”

ठमे: “चच्ये।”

- Fill in the blanks with the correct verb and verb ending. Notice if it is a question or an answer.
- The next section is about numbers 1-5. Write the correct number word in the blanks.
- ठोतो: Read these sentences out loud for practice.

Special Note:

* As you see in the number section, the number adjective comes after the noun. For example: थिड फिल, not फिल थिड.
