This chapter features 4 words that begin with “ड”

डेप. - ‘to spill’

ड. - ‘five’

डिप - ‘to laugh’

डोक्रोड. - ‘forehead’

Chapter 3 Spelling Rule: The full nasal marker ँ is used for all nasals. For example: खें, पाङ्च्यें, डोंस थप. The only time there is just a nasal dot is when there are already two features above the line, such as in the word छ्योर्ते, which has the r + e + nasal all in one place.

- Write each word with the nasal marker.
- Write other words you can think of that have the nasal marker.
- Create your own sentences with these three words.
- Read the example of the exception to the rule when a nasal can be written as a dot.
