

Chapter 21 - श्य

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “श्य”

·श्याड नोँ - ‘garlic’

·शियड - ‘wood’

श्यो - ‘wooden teacup’

श्य· चुप - ‘rainbow’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with श्य.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

Chapter 21 Spelling Rule: The phrase for ‘whenever’ in the Nyeshangte language is written हायाड ·पिले verb+कोनी, with the suffix -कोनी connected to the end of the verb. Adding this suffix does not change the spelling of the verb (as an aspect/tense suffix does).

हायाड ·पिले फ्रो यपकोनी, ड पे ·तु याड मो। - ‘Whenever I walk, I am very tired.’

The phrase for ‘until’ in the Nyeshangte language is written आ+verb ·तोनी, with a negative prefix आ- on the verb.

आचप ·तोनी ड ·फो श्हेन्च मो। - ‘Until I eat, I am hungry.’

- Read the two हायाड ·पिले examples then complete the two sentences.
- Read the two आ+verb ·तोनी examples then complete the two sentences.
- Read the numbers in the box and look at the sample pictures.
- Write your own sentences using the numbers ६, ६६, and ६६६.
