

Chapter 13 - न

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “न”

नकी - ‘rice sifter’

ना - ‘forest’

नाङ्ताड - ‘morning’

नोकोर - ‘cat’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with न.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

Chapter 13 Spelling Rule: Nyeshangte numbers 10-20 as well as multiples of ten (20, 30, 40...) are written as one word, not hyphenated. Example: ‘eleven’ is चुक्री, ‘twenty-one’ is डिश्यु-शिह.

- Read each of the ten number words.
- Count the dots out loud and then write the number word in the blank underneath.
- टोतो: Read these sentences out loud for practice.
