

Chapter 29 - ು

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “ु”

ुउकड - ‘owl’

उकर्या - ‘yellow’

उशु - ‘apple’

ुउड - ‘to cover (with a lid)’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with ು.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

- Chapter 29 Spelling Rule: A **low-falling tone** word is marked with a mid tone at the end of the word:

खेॆ, क्रिॆ, पिडॆ, खुडॆ, फ्राॆ, म्येॆ

- Read the four words in chart at the top of the page. Each word represents one of the four tones in the Nyeshangte language. This lesson is focusing on low-falling toned words. Low-falling toned words are written with a mid dot at the end of the word. (When typed, it is usually control+alt+` to create the mid dot.)
- To practice writing the fall-falling tone dots, simply re-write the words in the chart below.

- * Write 1-2 sentences about your day. Try to use words with low-falling tone!
