

Chapter 8 - छ्य

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “छ्य”

छ्य - ‘grass’

छ्युलाड - ‘crocodile’

छ्येमे - ‘candle’

छ्ये - ‘book’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with छ्य.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

Chapter 8 Spelling Rule: When writing a verb sequence such as यप + लाङ्प (“need to go”), the -प ending on the second verb is dropped (and the halanta as well, if the verb root ends in -ड).

यप + लाङ्प = यप लाड

म्राङ्प + लाङ्प = म्राड लाड

- Write each verb + लाङ्प correctly and then create sentences for each one.
- Look at the picture; read the words in the bubbles, and fill in the blanks.
