This chapter features 4 words that begin with “त”

तड्ड - ‘fish’

ताड्तु - ‘drum’

त - ‘horse’

तड्क्यु - ‘saucepan with lid’

Chapter 11 Spelling Rule: Imperative/Command suffixes are connected to the verb. This will change the spelling of the verb root: the ड्ड requires a halanta, nasal letters change, and the consonant right before the verb ending becomes a half character.

फाड्प → फाड्णो!

प्रिड्प → प्रिड्णो!

टोप → टोतो!

यप → यरो!
