

Chapter 2 - ख

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “ख”

खन्चयी - ‘jacket’

खिड - ‘snow’

खु - ‘broth’

खोन्ता - ‘pillow’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with ख.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

Chapter 2 Spelling Rule: When adding the -को suffix to चु (‘this’) and उ (‘that’), the pronunciation *and* spelling changes. For example:

चु + -को = चोको

चुको ता? - ‘What is this?’

उ + -को = ओको

उको ता? - ‘What is that?’

- Fill in the blanks with either चु or चोको.
- Create your own sentences with चु and चोको.
- Fill in the blanks with either उ or ओको.
- Create your own sentences with उ and ओको.
- टोतो: Read these sentences out loud for practice.

Special Note:

* There are some cases in the Nyeshangte language when the spelling reflects the pronunciation, such as चु and चोको. However, there are also cases when the spelling does not reflect the pronunciation, such as युलरी (correct spelling) and युल्ली (correct pronunciation but incorrect spelling).
