

Chapter 27 - आ

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “आ”

·आलो - ‘potato’

आखे - ‘grandfather’

आम - ‘mother’

आलोड - ‘wave, water current’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with आ.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

- Chapter 27 Spelling Rule: A **high-falling tone** word is marked with a high dot right before the word AND a mid tone at the end of the word:
·मि·, ·क·, ·फुड, ·टुल्प·, ·योप·, ·ठि·
- Read the four words in chart at the top of the page. Each word represents one of the four tones in the Nyeshangte language. This lesson is focusing on high-falling toned words. High-falling toned words are written with a high dot right before the word AND a mid dot at the end of the word. (When typed, it is usually control+alt+] keys pressed at the same time to create the high dot, and then control+alt+\ to create the mid dot.)
- To practice writing the high-falling tone dots, simply re-write the words in the chart below.

Additional activities:

- * Write 1-2 sentences about your day. Try to use words with high-falling tone!
