

Chapter 7 - च्य

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “च्य”

·च्याकें - ‘shovel’

च्याच्यो - ‘Tibetan twisted fried bread’

च्युतु - ‘leopard’

·च्ये· पिड - ‘teapot’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with च्य.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Chapter 7 Spelling Rule: Suffixes are added to the end of verbs to show tense and aspect.

When connecting these verb endings, the ड़ requires a halanta, nasal letters change, and consonant right before the verb ending becomes a half character.

पिम्प + -च्यी = पिन्च्यी

·थुङ्प + -च्यी = ·थुङ्च्यी

·कुल्प· + च्यी = ·कुल्च्यी·

- Write these nine words with their verb endings attached.
- Complete the next nine words by attaching their verb endings. Follow the above spelling rules for adding verb tense/aspect suffixes.
- Create your own sentences using the following verbs with the indicated verb endings.
- टोतो: Read these sentences out loud for practice.

Special Note:

* Just a reminder - If a suffix changes the tense/aspect of the verb, the spelling of the verb changes to accommodate. If a suffix (such as a plural, locative, or ergative marker) is added to a word, the spelling of the original word does not change.

Additional activities:

* Write 1-2 sentences about a place you went today. Try to use verbs with the -च्ये ending.
