

Chapter 1 - क

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “क”

कम्सा - ‘scarf’

कश्यो - ‘teacup’

कोला - ‘child’

कोतोलो - ‘ball’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with क.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

Chapter 1 Spelling Rule: When adding the suffix -री to a word to communicate ‘in,’ ‘on,’ ‘at,’ ‘to,’ the -री is always spelled with the *long* ‘i.’ In addition, adding -री to a word does not require half characters or a halanta after a ड. For example:

ख्या + -री = ख्यारी

तुकाड + -री = तुकाडरी

मि + -री = मिरी

- Add the suffix -री to each word by writing it in the blank space.
- Look at the picture and write the correct word with the attached -री in the blank space.
- टोटो: Read these sentences out loud for practice.

Special Note:

* You will hear a difference in the -री ending depending on what word it is connected to. For example, the word ‘house’ might sound like थिडदी, and the word ‘village’ might sound like युल्ली. The -री spelling does not change. It is always spelled -री even if it is pronounced differently. The correct way to spell ‘in the house’ is थिडरी and the correct way to spell ‘in the village’ is युल्ली.
