

Chapter 24 - ह

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “ह”

हासी - ‘knife’

होक्तोड - ‘hole’

हु - ‘crowd’

हाल्को - ‘plastic basin’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with ह.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

Chapter 1 Spelling Rule: Adding the phrase ‘ति तच्ये’ to the verb communicates that it is ‘time to do’ that action of that verb. The verb stays in dictionary form with the nominalized -प suffix ending.

‘सिकी चप ‘ति तच्ये। - ‘It is time to eat food.’

When communicating ‘might’ or ‘maybe’ with a modal verb, the morpheme आ is added after the verb (not attached to it).

क्य ‘सिकी चपा? - ‘Will you eat food?’

ड ‘सिकी च आ... - ‘I might eat...’

To add the adverb ‘just’ when communicating that something was recently done, the word हा is added right before the verb.

ड हा चच्यी। - ‘I just ate.’
