लपु - ‘radish’

लाङ्च्ये - ‘elephant’

लिडी - ‘moon’

लाम्क्ये - ‘eagle’

च्यिम्प + नो → च्यिन्नो

प्रिम्प + च मो → प्रिन्च मो
