

Chapter 25 - ल्ह

This chapter features 4 words that begin with “ल्ह”

ल्हाप - ‘wind’

ल्हो खप - ‘to cough’

ल्हप्टी - ‘art, painting’

ल्ह - ‘god’

Page 1 activities:

- Begin by writing each word 4 times each.
- Think of other words in the Nyeshangte language that begin with ल्ह.
- Using the 4 featured words, choose the word that best fits each sentence and write it in the blank space.
- Create your own sentences using the 4 featured words.

Page 2 activities:

Chapter 25 Spelling Rule: In order to communicate ‘even though’ in Nyeshangte, the main verb takes the suffix -ले. If it is a negative statement, the verb also takes the negation prefix आ-

मो आयुले ंना. ंकेप मोमु। - ‘Even though it didn’t rain, the forest is beautiful.’

मनाङ पे था. ंरुङ्प. मोले डि ंउरी लाके लाके य ल खें। -

‘Even though Manang is very far away, we can go there again and again.’

In order to communicate that something is ‘ok to do,’ the suffix ले is added to the verb root followed by the adjective त.

चिरी ंनुले त। - ‘It is ok to sleep here.’

- Read the example sentences for ‘ok to do,’ then complete your own sentences.
